Major Occupations

The General Construction Industry is primarily engaged in building and construction work in the residential and non-residential sectors. The majority of work is on new structures with a proportion involved in alterations and additions to existing buildings. Over half a million workers are employed in the building and construction industry, and of these, over half are employed in construction trade sectors. There are many factors influencing changes in the industry, including trend changes and environmental obligations. The needs of these changes are being matched by variations in education and training to support and lead the industry into the future. Some examples of related occupations include:

CPC20108 - Certificate II in Construction

This is the base entry point for this sector of the General Construction Industry and provides people with a range of core and underpinning skills and knowledge relevant to work as a construction assistant

CPC30108 - Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying

This is the trade qualification for Bricklayers/Blocklayers. It is the entry point for Apprentice Bricklayers and provides people with a range of core and underpinning skills and knowledge relevant to work in this field.

CPC31308 - Certificate III in Wall and Floor Tiling

This is the trade qualification for Tilers who learn to lay ceramic, clay, slate, marble, glass and other types of tiles on external and internal walls and floors to provide protective and decorative finishes.

CPC30608 - Certificate III in Painting and Decorating

This is the trade qualification for Painters and Decorators.

This is the trade qualification for Carpenters. It is the entry point for Apprentice Carpenters and provides people with a range of core and underpinning skills and knowledge relevant to work in this field.

CPC31208 - Certificate III in Wall and Ceiling Lining

This is the trade qualification for Fibrous Plasterers and includes training in manufacture, application and fixing of internal linings on commercial and domestic buildings.
